

Job Description: Health Team, Camp Young Judaea, Amherst, NH

Job Length: June 18 - August 19, 2024

Who We Are: For 84 years, Camp Young Judaea in southern New Hampshire has provided a nurturing, residential summer camping experience where kids of all Jewish backgrounds feel free to be themselves, deepen both their Jewish knowledge and connection to Israel, and develop meaningful relationships that last a lifetime. We are more than a summer camp. We are a caring community grounded in the Jewish values of *chesed* (caring and compassion), *tikkun olam* (repairing the world), commitment to a diverse and pluralistic Jewish community.

Our community is composed of:

- 400 campers largely from the eastern seaboard and their families at least 30% of our campers have a parent who went to CYJ
- Summer staff of 100 counselors 60% of whom are former campers and 30% are international
- 20 summer administrators, specialists, and medical professionals all of whom are college graduates and some with 10+ years of experience at CYJ
- 6 year-round staff (current configuration: f/t Executive Director, f/t Chief Operating Officer, f/t Director of Facilities, f/t Development and Operations Manager, p/t Director of Recruitment and Family Engagement, p/t Director of Alumni Engagement)
- 4,000 active alumni many of whose children and grandchildren attend camp

At our 168-acre site on the shores of Lake Baboosic — fondly known as Baboo — we welcome children 8-15 years-old (completing grades 2-9) for 2 week, 3 ½ week and 7 week sessions. Our oldest campers (completing grade 10) participate in a culminating, educational experience in Israel for 5 weeks and then return to camp "deep in the hills of New Hampshire" for 2 weeks of leadership training. Camp Young Judaea is a private, independent, non-profit organization and is not affiliated with the Young Judaea movement or other camps with similar names. We are proud to be the original Camp Young Judaea.

Nurse:

Essential job functions -

- Maintain complete and up to date health records.
- Provide comprehensive nursing assessment to campers and staff and intervene as appropriate in accordance with standing orders.
- Ensure safe medication packaging, storage and administration in accordance with camp policies and procedures.
- Respond quickly tol medical emergencies and seek additional medical support as needed.
- Communicate any and all health concerns or emergencies to the Director of Health Services.
- Communicate with parents/guardians and staff as necessary.

- Registered Nurse

Nursing Student:

Essential job functions -

- Carry out daily operations of the health center under supervision of RN.
- Assess and triage patients under direction of RN and MD.
- Lead med passes 4x daily under direction and supervision of RN.
- Respond to medical emergencies and provide nursing support to campers and counselors on-site.

Qualifications:

- Completed at least 1 clinical rotation at an accredited school of nursing.
- Attitude of flexible, dependable service, consistent work ethic and a commitment to CYJ and its goals.
- A willingness to step in to support unexpected turns of events.
- Ability to communicate effectively, creatively, and enthusiastically with a variety of ages, both children and adults, as well as camper parents.
- Commitment to being at CYJ for the entire summer 2024. Housing and 3 meals per day provided.
